FREE GRAB N' GO FOOD PROGRAM

- On Friday, April 24 and May 1, in partnership with the United Way and Eat n' Park, meals for adults will be distributed at the same time as the student meals between 11:00 and 1:00. This is first-come first-serve until meals run out.
- The Fresh Fruit and Vegetable program will be returning soon. Watch for it! The state is requiring that students be present to receive these additional fruits and vegetables.

Students may receive GRAB and GO Breakfast and Lunch Monday through Friday from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM at the following locations:

As of 3/23/2020 the PA Summer Food Service Program still requires that students need to be present to receive the meal(s). Woodland Hills does not have a waiver for parent|guardian only meal pick up. The SFSP meals are made available on a first-come first-serve basis. Every effort will be made to have meals available daily for all children who want to receive a meal but there may be occasions where demand exceeds what was prepared. These are open sites where any child may receive a meal and demand varies each day.

- **District Administration Building located at 531 Jones Ave North Braddock PA 15104**

Meals will be distributed to students at the side entrance located next to the parking lot.

- **East Pittsburgh Community Center|Gym located at 506 Bessemer Ave and Main St East Pittsburgh PA 15112**

Meals will be distributed in the parking lot of the Community Center at Bessemer Ave and Main Street.

- **Rankin School located at 235 Fourth Ave Rankin PA 15104**

Meals will be distributed at the front entrance of the building.

- **Turtle Creek Elementary Steam Academy located at 126 Monroeville Ave Turtle Creek PA 15145**

Meals will be distributed to students from door #2 located at the driveway to the right of the front entrance to the school.

- **Woodland Hills Intermediate School located at 7600 Evans Street Swissvale PA 15218**

Meals will be distributed to students from door #2 located to the right of the entrance ramp to the school.

- **Students may receive meals at the location that is most convenient to their home.**
- **Students will receive one lunch and one breakfast at the same time.**
- **Students will receive additional meals for the weekend on Thursday and Friday.**

- The meals are intended to be GRAB and GO. The facilities will not be open to use as a place to eat the meals.
- The State of Pennsylvania still stipulates that students need to be present to receive the meal(s). The district does not have a waiver for parent | guardian only pick up.

Propel Braddock Hills Elementary School is serving meals 10:00 AM to Noon Mondays and Thursdays. Breakfast and Lunch. Multiple days meals at each distribution.
